tree	A tree is a plant that has a long trunk with branches and leaves extending from the trunk.		The names of a variety of deciduous trees.				
deciduous	Deciduous trees are trees that lose their leaves in the autumn and grow new leaves in the spring.		The names of a variety of evergreen trees.				
evergreen	Evergreen trees do not lose their leaves. They stay green all year round.		The parts that make up a tree (roots, trunk, branches and leaves).				
branches	The parts of a tree which grow out from the trunk and have leaves, flowers or fruit growing on them.		The hours of daylight change over the four seasons				
trunk	The large main stem of a tree, from which the branches grow.						
leaves	The leaves are the parts of a plant (tree) that are flat, thin and usually green.						
roots	The roots are the part of a plant which make it stable and take in both food and water. Roots are usually hidden under the ground.
