- Zambia has a tropical climate so it is warm for most of the year. There is a dry season and a wet season.
- Mugurameno Village is located in Zambia next to the River Zambezi.
- People in Mugurameno use the river for many things such as washing, fishing and watering crops. One of the main crops is maize, used for making nshima (a sort of porridge).
- People often build their own homes out of bricks made from local clay soil.
