



# Year 2 Science: Plants

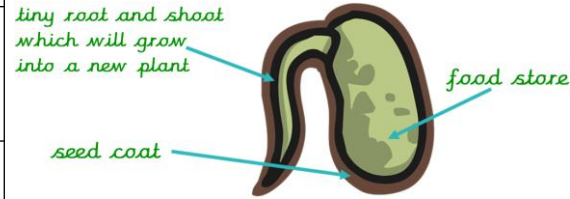
## Vocabulary

<b>lifecycle</b>	the changes and developments that a living thing goes through from the beginning of its life until its death
<b>germinate</b>	when a new plant bursts out of its seed
<b>bulb</b>	underground masses of food storage from which plants grow
<b>seed</b>	the first stage in most plant lifecycles Every plant has a different seed
<b>seedling</b>	a young plant, especially one raised from a seed
<b>identify</b>	finding out the name of something
<b>observe</b>	examine and watch something closely
<b>conditions</b>	the things that plants need to grow (sun, shade, warm, cool, water)
<b>healthy</b>	when a plant has all the conditions to grow well

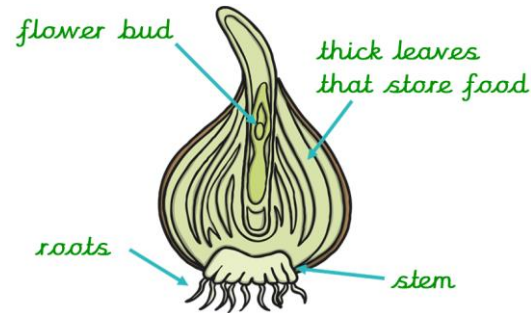
## Key Knowledge

All plants grow from seeds or bulbs.

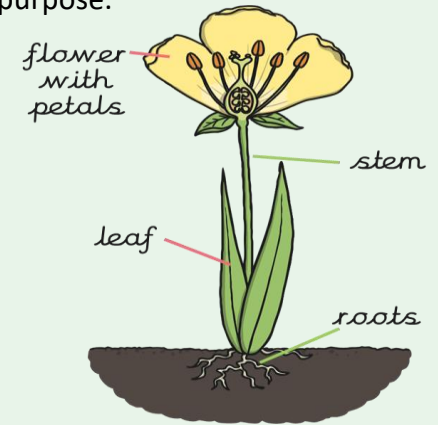
### Seed

Plants are made up of different parts which all have a different purpose.



- These plants may have flowers which develop into seeds, berries and fruits.
- Seeds and bulbs develop and grow into seedlings which then grow into mature plants.

- Seeds and bulbs need to be planted outside at particular times of the year and they will grow at different rates.

- Some plants are better suited to growing in full sun and some grow better in the shade.

- Plants also need different amounts of water and space to grow well and stay healthy.
